What are the meal options at Calabash?

Bed & breakfast, half board and all-inclusive options are available, with guests able to choose from the à la carte menus for dinner at Rhodes Restaurant, Nori or The Beach Club.

What kind of traveller does Calabash suit best?

Ideal for low-key luxury seekers who value privacy, space and great service. Great for couples and honeymooners.

How does it compare to other resorts in Grenada?

Calabash is the most discreetly luxurious option, less about facilities, more about finesse.

Is Grenada a good alternative to other Caribbean islands?

Grenada is not about spectacle, it's about depth and ease. If your idea of a great long-haul trip is beautiful beaches, excellent food, genuine character, and no stress, it's one of the most compelling alternatives to the usual luxury hotspots right now.

How long should guests stay?

7-nights is the sweet spot. Long enough to enjoy the beaches, explore the island, and still unwind without feeling rushed.

Is the resort suitable for families?

Yes, but with an important caveat: Calabash Hotel is family-friendly, not family-focused. The hotel is family-run and genuinely warm toward children, with staff known for engaging personally with younger guests. It has flexible accommodations with interconnecting suites and villas that make it easy to accommodate families of different sizes. The hotel can arrange tailored kids' activities via concierge-style planning.

When is the best time to book?

Ideally book 9-12 months in advance especially for peak periods and secure the suite you want.

What usually surprises guests?

Guests are often surprised by how unshowy yet deeply polished Calabash Hotel feels in person. It doesn't behave like a typical "big name luxury resort"- and that contrast is what stands out most.

Is it suitable for honeymoons?

Yes, Calabash Hotel is one of the best honeymoon hotels in Grenada, and it's very deliberately designed with couples in mind.

You might frame it around:

- The renowned Rhodes Restaurant in an open-air garden
- Breakfast served on your balcony or the sands of L’Anse Aux Epines
- Local nutmeg, cocoa, and saffron used in menus and spa rituals
- Tapas-style lunches at the Beach Club, steps from the water

The Gentle Side of the Caribbean

Focus on calm waters and the unhurried pace of the island.

This works well for:

- Honeymooners wanting a serene, low-noise environment
- Wellness seekers looking for a holistic, restorative break
- Clients who prefer a quiet beach over a crowded hub

You might frame it around:
