The Pool Residences and Pool Penthouses are designed in an apartment-style layout and are set slightly apart from the main hotel, connected via a skywalk. These spacious accommodations include private terrace pools and dedicated butler service, offering a more residential, “live like a local” feel while still enjoying full resort facilities.

## LUX\* Grand Gaube Teens Club

A dedicated teen space located next to the kids club, Studio 17 offers a safe, supervised environment where teenagers can relax and socialise independently. Facilities include table tennis, basketball, pool tables, a gaming zone with PlayStation and Xbox, creative spaces like the Junk Art Gallery, and a chill-out lounge—making it ideal for both active fun and downtime, with options to privatise for special events.

### A Stroll in the Past

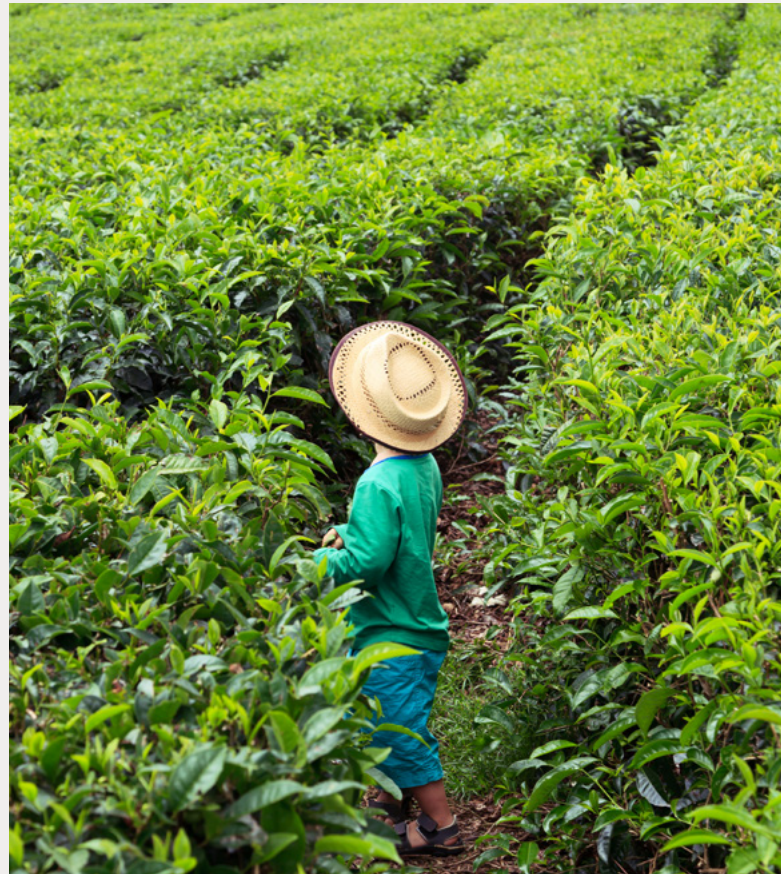

# FAQs

### What are the meal options?

All the LUX\* Resorts on Mauritius include breakfast as standard and offer half-board, full-board and all inclusive. Each resort has a wide range of dining options, most of which are included for lunch and dinner on half-board, full-board and all inclusive.

### What kind of traveller do the resorts suit best?

With four resorts spread across the island, LUX\* cater for everyone, from the lively resort of Grand Baie, to the more secluded and romantic Le Morne, no one will be disappointed with a LUX\* stay. Belle Mare is really good for families.

### How do they compare to other resorts in Mauritius?

The LUX\* Resorts are some of the very best in Mauritius. They may not be the Ultra Luxury of One&Only Le Saint Geran or Four Seasons but are excellent properties with well designed rooms, top class restaurants and destination spas. They are more modern in feel than a traditional Mauritian resort and are not fully all-inclusive resorts like Heritage Awali, for example.

### Is Mauritius a good alternative to other Indian Ocean islands such as the Maldives or Seychelles?

Price point and airlift tends to make Mauritius a more affordable way to experience an Indian Ocean resort when compared to the Maldives or Seychelles. The experience is a little different where the Maldives are all private island resorts, and Seychelles covers several smaller islands, Mauritius is self-contained with all hotels dotted around the coast. The sea, watersports and resorts are all exactly what you would expect of the Indian Ocean.

### How long should guests stay?

Due to the flight time, we wouldn't really think of anything less than 7 nights in Mauritius, while 10-14 night stays are perfect with so much to fill time in resort or exploring the island.

### Are the resorts suitable for families?

Yes, all four LUX\* Resorts in Mauritius are well geared for families of all ages, with great facilities, kids & teen clubs and many activities available to most age groups. LUX\* Belle Mare and LUX\* Grand Gaube are the two resorts most popular with families.

### When is the best time to book?

As always, booking is best with plenty of lead time. Booking further in advance will usually allow access to the best offers and more availability. Seasons can vary dramatically depending on location in Mauritius. North for Grand Baie and Grand Gaube is a good option all year round, while the east and south west coasts are best during the summer, but winter should not be discounted with calmer and warmer seas.

### What usually surprises guests?

All the resorts will pull out the stops to surprise and delight guests, from pop-up activities, stand out dining experiences, wellness with a twist plus creative and cultural touches such as art spaces. The island itself is a lush green paradise with clear lagoons, and impressive waterfalls to be discovered.

### Is it suitable for honeymoons?

Absolutely. All four LUX\* Resorts cater for honeymooners, often having offers specifically aimed at honeymoon couples plus romantic rooms, secluded settings and options for private dining and fantastic dining options.
