Morning

Start the day with breakfast at Carpe Diem, or enjoy it in the privacy of your suite or villa via in-room dining. Mornings at Nana Princess are best kept simple and unhurried—whether that means time on your private terrace, a swim in your private pool (in selected categories), or a relaxed start before heading down to the sea or spa.

Midday

Late morning and lunchtime work well either by the main pool or at Artemis Lounge, which is ideal for lighter dishes, drinks and a more informal setting. This is also a good time to book a treatment at the Royal Wellness Club, enjoy tennis or watersports, head out on an excursion such as sailing or Spinalonga, or, for families, make use of the children’s facilities and activities available through the neighbouring Nana Golden Beach.

Late Afternoon

The late afternoon is best spent back in your suite or villa, making the most of what sets Nana Princess apart: the privacy, space and high-spec accommodation. Depending on your room category, this may mean time in your private heated pool, outdoor Jacuzzi, steam room, sauna or simply enjoying a quieter hour before dinner.

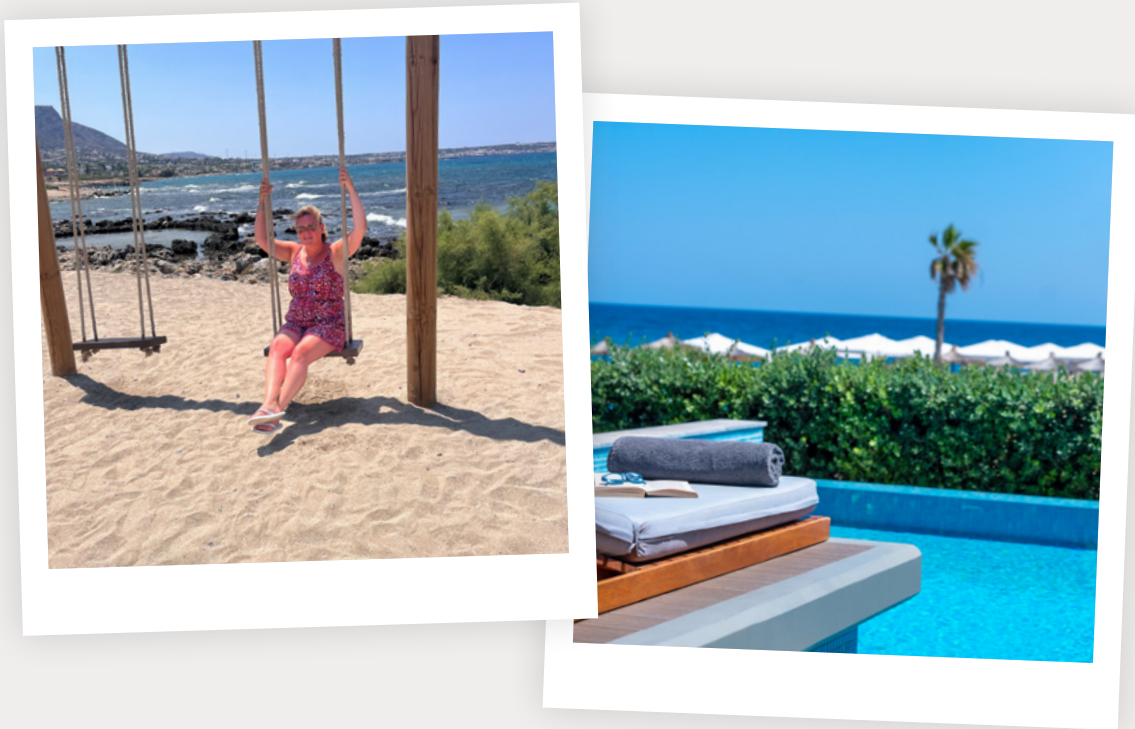

Visit Spinalonga Island

What are the meal options at Nana Princess Suites, Villas & Spa?

Bed & Breakfast and 'Dine Plus' half board are the two options. Breakfast is served in Carpe Diem. Dine Plus includes dinner at two à la carte restaurants (Eternal Blue and Meat-in Point) with free choice from the à la carte menu (4-course dinner excluding drinks). Reservations are required.

What kind of traveller does Nana Princess Suites, Villas & Spa suit best?

There is something for everyone and perfect if you're seeking the privacy of your own pool. Good for families, couples, honeymooners and those who love time in the spa.

How do the properties compare to other resorts in Crete?

Nana Princess stands comfortably alongside Crete's top luxury resorts, distinguished by its sleek contemporary style, highly private suite-and-villa concept, and strong spa offering.

Is Crete a good alternative to other Greek destinations?

As Greece's largest island, Crete offers a remarkable sense of scale, combining world-class beaches, mountain scenery, historic sites and authentic villages in a way few other Greek destinations can match.

How long should guests stay?

The ideal length would be between five and seven nights – long enough to enjoy the resort properly, make the most of the spa, dining and private-pool lifestyle, and still fit in a few excursions such as Spinalonga or a sailing day.

Is the resort suitable for families?

Yes, it is very family-friendly, offering thoughtful in-suite children's amenities, dedicated children's menus at restaurants and snack bars, and access to the neighbouring Nana Golden Beach's mini-club, playgrounds and activity rooms. Meals and drinks are charged separately at neighbouring Nana Golden Beach.

When is the best time to book?

Book 6 to 9 months in advance to secure early booking deals and the best flight prices.

What usually surprises guests?

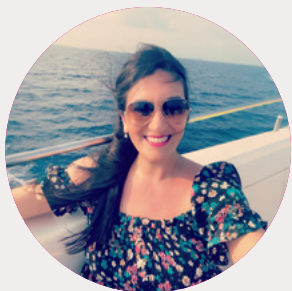
